- * Pick a Veteran to interview**

What was their job in the military? How they felt to be in the service and how they felt when they returned to civilian life? After returning what shaped their life? Family, kids, job? How did their military experience shape them as a civilian? If they had it to do over again, would they re-enlist?**

Requirements:

- * You must be a Junior or Senior in High School studying American History or American Government.**

Essay Guidelines:

- * All entries must be double-spaced and in 12 pt. font (Calibri). There is no minimal length requirement. Your essay will be evaluated on how well you write up your experience/interview with your Veteran.**

- * Your essay needs to be submitted by Sunday, April 28th., 2024 at midnight CST.**
