

Creating your FSA ID (Parent)

1. Go to fsaid.ed.gov
2. Under the “Create an FSA ID” tab, create a unique username and password. Username is 6-30 characters long, any combination of numbers and letters, not case-sensitive. Password is 8-30 characters, case-sensitive, and must have numbers, uppercase letters, and lowercase letters. Confirm password.

3. Click on “Continue.” Enter your first and last name. Enter your birthdate and your social security number. (No ssn? Enter all zeros).
4. Click on “Continue.” Enter and confirm your personal email address. Do not use your child’s email address – student and parent email addresses must be different.
